SPECIAL INTEREST SECTIONS -- are you a member?

Membership in special interest sections provides meaningful networking opportunities for OEM professionals with shared interests in specialized areas of OEM. Tools for members and position papers of the College are often developed by the sections. Ongoing discussion via listservs, websites, and teleconferences provide section members the opportunity to remain up to date on issues relevant to their area of interest. Academic Occ. Medicine \$10

Covers issues pertinent to occupational and environmental medicine education as well as promoting education and training of physicians who do or will practice OEM.

Admin. Management in OEM \$25

For physicians who provide services to external entities. This section offers a strong foundation in the administrative skills necessary to deliver services in a productive, cost-effective manner.

Corporate Medicine \$25

For corporate occupational health directors and others whose practice or main interest is in corporate medicine.

Environmental Health \$25

As environmental exposures differ from occupational exposures in that they impact all segments of the population, the mission of this Section is to provide a forum for ACOEM members with research, clinical, consulting, or policy interests in this expanding and changing health arena to facilitate their interest in and to develop actions for addressing environmental health issues. The Section will conduct educational activities to address environmental health issues, and will coordinate its activities with other environmental health organizations and government agencies such as the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA).

Federal & Military OEM \$20

Share information and discuss areas of mutual concern and interest among members who serve on active duty in the armed services or public health service.

Health & Productivity \$25

For physicians with an interest in guidelines for the assessment and evaluation of measurements of productivity and systems for tracking such measurements in the workplace.

International: US \$25 Foreign \$10

For physicians with an interest in international medicine, this section serves as a focal point for health care professionals desiring information on OEM around the world.

Medical Center Occ. Health \$10

Provides opportunities for participation in educational sessions, open forums, and Internet guideline updates for those with a particular interest in the health and safety of health care facility employees.

Medical Informatics \$20

Find out about issues pertinent to computer uses for occupational and environmental medicine physicians.

Medical Review Officers \$10

Medical Review Officers who are interested in current topics in occupational and environmental medicine.

Nuclear Industry Physicians \$30

Physicians interested in interaction among industry, labor, science, government and public agencies to control occupational and environmental health hazards associated with nuclear energy.

Occ. Health Law & Policy \$15

For those with an interest or expertise in legal and policy issues related to occupational and environmental medicine.

Occ. Physicians/Physician Assts \$10

Encourages use of a team concept between the physician and physician assistant in occupational and environmental medicine.

Pharmaceutical Industry \$25

Promotes dialogue pertaining to the occupational and preventive health issues of the pharmaceutical industry.

Private Practice in Occ. Medicine \$25

Focuses on information exchange, education and state-of-the-art care in occupational and environmental medicine.

Public Safety Medicine \$15

Focuses on occupational & environmental concerns regarding fire, police, correction officers, crossing guards, and other public safety professionals.

Residents & Recent Graduates \$10

An exchange forum for residents or recent graduates of occupational medicine residency and fellowship programs.

Transportation \$10

Covers issues related to the health and safety of individuals in various transportation industries.

Underserved Occ. Populations \$25

Forum for those interested in special occupational health problems experienced by underserved populations such as migrant workers, off-shore commercial fisherman, loggers, hospitality workers, etc.; focus on educating health professionals, stimulating research, and guiding public policy.

Work Fitness & Disability \$25

Physicians with special interests in disability prevention and management, return-to-work planning, as well as accurate work fitness and disability/impairment determinations.
